Loraine Materasso Endorses Makki and Heads Up 'Homeschool Parents for Makki'

St. Petersburg, FL – *Homeschool Parents for Makki* is a new coalition to increase the momentum of Amanda Makki's grassroots campaign. With Florida leading the nation in new ways to bring opportunities in education to families, parents in Pinellas County are looking to tap Amanda Makki to be their advocate in Congress.

I am overjoyed to have such great educators joining my campaign to solidify that our community has a strong voice on Education in Congress," said Makki.

Homeschool Parents for Makki marks Amanda Makki's fourth coalition to date. Other groups supporting Amanda Makki for Congress are: Cops for Makki, headed by Cpl. Steve Squillante, Veterans for Makki, headed by Marine Corps Captain (former) Matt Tito, and Bikers for Makki is headed by Keith Overton and Bert King of Bert's Barracuda.

As the Republican frontrunner candidate for Florida's 13th Congressional District, Amanda Makki has received the endorsements from esteemed military veterans including Senator Joni Ernst, the first female combat veteran ever elected to the United States Senate, Congressmen Michael Waltz (Lt. Colonel), Congressman Neal Dunn (Major), and Combat veteran Robert O'Neill of the elite Navy SEAL Team 6, who shot Osama bin Laden.

In addition, she is endorsed by House Republican Leader Kevin McCarthy, Republican Whip Steve Scalise, Health Care Ranking Member and Physician Michael Burgess, as well as Florida Congressional Representatives John Rutherford and Neal Dunn. Locally, Amanda has the support of Seminole City Councilor Thom Barnhorn, Belleair Beach Mayor Joseph Manzo and Treasure Island Commissioner Tyler Payne. Additionally, Amanda has received over 20 major endorsements including the Conservative groups FreedomWorks, Republican Main Street Partnership PAC, and Maverick PAC as well as groups supporting the strongest female candidates in the U.S. including VIEW PAC, Maggie's List, and Rep. Elise Stefanik's E-PAC, that help female GOP candidates. She is also supported by the American College of Emergency Physicians and Associated Builders & Contractors Florida Gulf Coast Chapter.
